Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Be mindful of others' personal space and belongings - Follow the adult's directions the first time - Make sure your voice is at the appropriate level (0, 1, 2, 3, 4) - Talk positively to everyone 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use quiet voices or stay silent in the hallway - Respect others' work on the wall - Use level 0-1 voice
Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Independent problem-solving - Report problems to an adult - Keep track of personal belongings - Remember to have permission before petting Ray 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Walk with a purpose
Be Safe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Always use walking feet inside - Keep all hands, feet and other objects to yourself (KAHFOOTY). - Be aware of your surroundings - Use line manners - Use a calm, quiet voice with Ray 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Face forward when you're walking
Be Kind	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Help others when they are in need - Use kind words with each other 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Smile at people passing you in the hallway

Each area of Stony Point has a matrix of expected behaviors. Teachers explicitly teach lessons based on each area and review each area's matrix with students. These matrices are posted around the building as reminders of our expected behaviors.
